BLAND DIET

A bland diet is frequently recommended when a dog/cat is experiencing a gastro-intestinal upset or recovery from a disease.

- Diet #1
 - 2 cups cooked white rice 1 cup boiled (drained) hamburger
- Diet #2
 - 2 cups cooked Cream of Wheat or oatmeal 1 ½ cups of cottage cheese 1 diced hard boiled egg
- Diet #3

A canned or dry Prescription Diet called I/D is available if you would prefer a ready made bland diet. I/D is also available for cats.

- * Give 1-5 tablespoons (depending on the size of your pet) of bland diet every 3-4 hours as long as there is no vemiting. Small frequent meals are vital.
- * Add 1-3 teaspoons (depending on the size of your pet) of plain unflavored yogurt per day if your dog is on an antibiotic from your veterinarian.
- * Add a source of fiber if diarrhea present, either canned Pumpkin (1-4 tablespoons depending on the size of your pet twice a day) or Metamucil (half or whole human dose depending on the size of your pet).
- * Feed the bland diet for 2-3 days, then gradually add small amounts of regular food to make a transition back to the animals regular diet.

If improvement does not occur, we need to see your pet. Please call the office if you have problems or questions.
